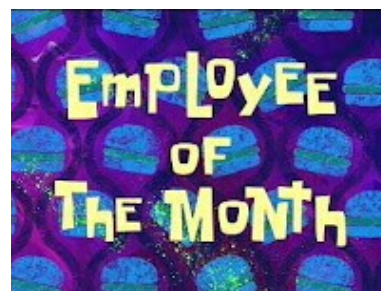
### Stallholders Wanted
